Additionally, he was the Sr. Vice Commander of VFW Post 3990 from 1993-1994, Post Commander, VFW 3990 from 1995-1996 and again from 2013-2018. Bud also volunteered his service to the local American Legion, Paris Post 30, and served as Commander, 2018-2020, and as Judge Advocate for District 1.

Bud is preceded in death by his father, Harvel E. Mackey Sr, his mother, Louise Kimmons, and stepfather, Robert M. Kimmons.
