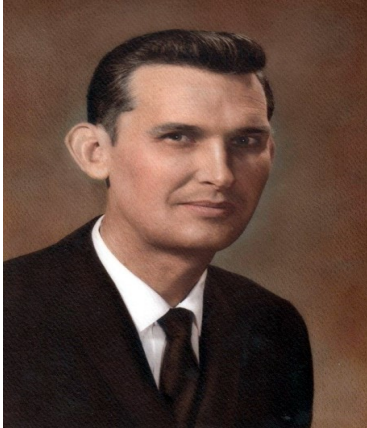


Horace Wendell Garner
